

The Redwood Capital Bancorp Board of Directors recently declared the 30th consecutive quarterly cash dividend. The dividend of \$0.07 per share was payable on August 9, 2019 to shareholders of record at the close of business on July 29, 2019. The dividend is equivalent to an annual rate of \$0.28 per share or 1.67%, based upon a market price of \$16.75 per common share.
